### **TUITION & FINANCIAL PHILOSOPHY**

Since the school's inception, the Board of Directors decided that 100% of the school's annual operating expenses be borne by those receiving the value: therefore, tuition and fees require some adjusting each year in order to cover <u>all</u> of the academy's operating expenses. As a result, Providence has never incurred any debt.

Because of the nature of the university-model, the cost of tuition for a full-time student will be less than a typical 5-day-a-week school. However, our desire to attract and retain the very best teachers will be reflected in our tuition as well.

Note: Providence Academy may choose to enroll high school students who are not Providence diploma-seeking students. Each student is evaluated on a case-by-case basis in consideration of the best outcomes for the student, the family, and the school. While Providence Academy does not offer any kind of diploma for such students, the student may accumulate course credits at Providence to place towards a self-managed high school plan. Individual classes are \$1,500 each and the Study Hall fee for off-periods is \$500.

# **Tuition Payment Plan**

Tuition payments are payable through the FACTS tuition management program in 12, 9, or 2 monthly installments beginning in June. A 2% discount on tuition can be taken if full payment is remitted at the time of registration, <u>but no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025</u>. A 5% discount can be taken on each additional student thereafter enrolled in the same family. Discount will be taken on youngest student(s). Pastors who receive 25% of their income from their pastoral duties will receive a 33% discount on tuition. Pastors must be considered clergy by the IRS, and the Board reserves the right to evaluate on a case-by-case basis. The Pastoral Discount cannot be combined with any other discounts.
